Find out about Henry VIII's famous ship the *Mary Rose* - she was built here in Portsmouth, sank here in 1545, was raised from the seabed here in 1982 and is now having an amazing new museum built in the City which will open in 2012

## Cubs

- Visit the Mary Rose Museum and take part in practical activities to find out more about the history of the ship and Tudor Portsmouth
- Use old maps to compare the Tudor town with our modern City to see how much has changed in 500 years
- Make your own 3D map of Tudor Portsmouth



Follow-up activity: You may like to walk around the Tudor sights from the Historic Dockyard through Old Portsmouth to Southsea Castle

## Scouts

Join in with group activities to find out about the Mary Rose and Portsmouth in Tudor times

- Load and fire a replica cannon
- Handle real and replica Tudor artefacts
- Investigate Tudor maps of Portsmouth
- Tour the museum

Follow-up: If you choose to create a display or exhibit based on the Mary Rose to finish off your badge we would be happy to put it on show in the current Mary Rose Museum
