RESTORING THE GLORY, BRINGING HISTORY ALIVE

Not only is the *Mary Rose* the world's only Sixteenth Century warship, she was Henry VIII's flagship and the pride of his fleet. One of the first warships to have gun ports, she began a 350 year period of naval history of broadside firing ships which led up to Trafalgar. But it is the combination of the ship herself and her amazing artefacts preserved at a recorded moment in time which gives us an incomparable collection of stories of Tudor life from King Henry VIII to the humble carpenter. These are what make the *Mary Rose* unique and give her such a prominent place in our Nation's heritage.

THE VISION

Our vision is to build a stunning new museum over the dry dock which currently houses the *Mary Rose*. This building will bring together, for the first time, the vessel and artefacts under one roof. There will be a contemporary interpretation of the port side of the hull. Once the drying out is complete and with the clever use of sound and visual effects, visitors will be able to get a real understanding of life onboard and experience the ship close up. The surrounding galleries will allow many more of the 19,000 artefacts to be displayed and the education facilities will be greatly enhanced. There will be an impressive viewing gallery overlooking the harbour and stern of that other great ship, *HMS VICTORY*.

THE CHALLENGE

The total project, including the final conservation, will cost in the order of £35m. There is no direct funding from the Government. As with all charities, successful fundraising is essential. We rely on the Heritage Lottery Fund and, of course, on support from the general public. Our Patrons Scheme is at the core of our public support.
